Multiple dogs with the same handler in the same level are allowed. Titling or FLO dog must be run first. For Exhibition Only (FEO) entries are accepted and run last.

## Important – please read!

#### It is the Competitor's responsibility to be familiar with the Rules and Regulations for USCSS<sup>™</sup>. USCSS-Rules-Ver.-3.1.pdf.

This is a **CLASSIC Tria**l. You MUST enter all 4 elements at a single level in order to earn the Classic Title. However, any and all Q's earned will also count towards the general USCSS Variable title requirements. If you have any questions, after checking the rule book contact the Trial Secretary for additional clarification.

**SAFETY:** All dogs must be on a 6' or shorter leash when not participating in a search. EVERY dog MUST maintain a minimum of 6' distance from all other dogs at ALL TIMES.

AWARDS: Ribbons will not be mailed.

- A qualifying ribbon will be given at the end of your run.
- 1st-4th place per class.
- Title ribbons are given upon earning the 3<sup>rd</sup> qualifying leg in an element or game, or upon completion of a level. See Section 15.1D for further explanation.
- # Tabs are also awarded on the 2nd-5th title in the same element/game, ie. CN5, but not for CN6+
- **HiT-** HIGH in TRIAL 1<sup>st</sup> place will be offered at all levels. High Champion and High Rescue will also be offered. HIGH in Trial 2-4th are NOT offered.

**CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!:** Dispose of waste in appropriate containers. Do NOT let your dog pee on items we have to touch! We are guests on this property, please be respectful.

**DESTRUCTION/DAMAGE to Search Area**: Section 17.7B -Handlers will be expected to make financial reparations to the event host or owner of the item that will cover the cost of replacement or repair to the damaged item. ie. vehicles, furniture.

**COLLARS & LEASHES:** Flexi/retractable leads are ONLY permitted during a search. Choke chains, prong collars or halti/head collars are NOT permitted during searches. Leashes of any length may be used while the dog is participating in a search. Dogs MUST be switched over to a 6' length or shorter leash when outside of the search area.

**CRATING**: Crating is at your vehicle. **Crating MUST BE in an enclosed crate.** Open top crates and exercise pens (xpens) are NOT PERMITTED for safety reasons. Be prepared to provide shade and water throughout the trial. It's Florida, the weather is capricous, at best.

**ELIGIBLE DOGS:** The following dogs are eligible to compete in USCSS<sup>™</sup> events:

- Dogs 6-months of age or older
- Dogs of any breed, purebred or mixed breed
- Blind, deaf or dogs with amputations or who use ambulatory carts
- Bitches in season, but they must wear panties and be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. If bringing a bitch in season, <u>please inform the trial</u> <u>secretary prior to the trial</u> and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing

**INELIGIBLE DOGS:** See Section 6.4 of the Rulebook.

**FOOD:** Bring your lunch as the closest store is 5+ miles away. If you'd like to share a bowl/plate of munchies, that would be awesome! Typically we do NOT take an official lunch break, but may take a short break at the Judges' discretion.

**PAYMENTS & WAIVERS:** Checks made out to **BCDTC** and mailed with the Waiver to **Marilyn Strout**, 3794 Long Grove Ln., Port Orange, FL 32129.

**REACTIVE DOGS: Brevard County Dog Training Club** accepts the entries of reactive dogs in USCSS<sup>™</sup> trials. Reactive dogs will be run first or last in the trial and all other dogs must be crated while the reactive dogs are preparing for the search. A 10-minute break will be given after the reactive dogs have run and are again crated to give the other teams time to prepare for their runs. USCSS<sup>™</sup> suggests that reactive dogs wear red bandannas. Please notify the Trial Secretary, in advance, if you have a reactive dog.

**REFUNDS & EVENT CANCELLATION:** Every attempt will be made to contact entrants if the event is cancelled or postponed. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

**SCHEDULE:** Final Judge assignments & run order will be determined after the closing date. Typically, we run Novice – Intermediate – Advanced – Games– Senior – Master - Extreme. Check In time "around 8:30 am" with a CSD Briefing at 8:50 am. First Dog Team(s) on the line at 9am. Details will be emailed in Welcome to Trial on Jan. 22, 2025

SMOKING/VAPING/ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: are NOT permitted on the grounds at this facility.

**SITE:** The trial will be held on private property indoors & outdoors. Surfaces used for searches will be wood, metal, concrete, dirt, and grass. No stairs are involved.

#### Steps for Joining USCSS™, Registering Dog and Entering this Trial

- 1. All competitors must become a member of USCSS<sup>™</sup>, which is **FREE**! Competitors may join here: <u>http://members.uscaninescentsports.com/signup</u>.
- Competitors must then register their dog(s) through the USCSS<sup>™</sup> website. Each registration includes a one-time \$25.00 fee. Competitors may register their dogs here: <u>http://members.uscaninescentsports.com/login</u>
- 3. Competitors then select which dog they are entering and select which Classes and/or Games they are entering.
- **T (Titling)** is for teams wanting to earn qualifying legs (scores) towards titles, placements/ribbons and be eligible for High in Trial awards (if all criteria are met).
- FLO (For Legs Only) is for teams wanting to earn qualifying legs (scores) towards titles, but no placements ribbons. You might choose this if you already have your title or are running an upper level dog at a lower level and possibly allowing less experienced teams a better chance to place. Judges MUST run FLO in any trial in which they are judging. FLO runs are not credited towards High in Trial (HiT) awards.
- FEO (For Exhibition Only) is for a team wanting to run two (2) dogs in the same class/level, or a team wanting to "practice". No qualifying leg is earned, and no placement/ribbon is awarded. If you are running two (2) dogs in the same class/level, the dog running for "practice" MUST be selected as FEO and will run AFTER the titling dog.
- 4 Competitors will then receive a computer generated email with details regarding their entry. They will then receive a 2<sup>nd</sup> email confirmation from <u>mitchstrout@yahoo.com</u> with further instructions. Please make sure to add mitchstrout@yahoo.com to your White List so messages do not end up in your SPAM folder. Entries must be paid by the Closing Date.
