Number of Entries: ***

**150 dogs per Judge. Multiple dogs are allowed at different levels. Titling dog must
run first if they are at the same level. Additional entries are allowed on the day of
the show at \$30 per run. However, there will be no additional entries if the trail
fills completely.**

***** Search areas are not nested. Competitors with multiple dogs may only run one
dog for a titling run in each of the classes. Any additional dogs running in the
same class must be run FEO.*****
